Dear Friends of the Book Bank,

In 2023, the Maryland Book Bank put 510,000 books into the hands of eager children and the adults in their lives who love to read to them—a record-setting year. So many caring and skillful hands make this kind of a milestone possible. Whether it’s our book and financial donors, staff, volunteers, or service corps members, I know we are all driven by a personal love for reading.

As beloved author Jacqueline Woodson reflects in “The Year We Learned to Fly,” stories give us wings. They help us to escape or to cope, depending on the need. They lift our spirits and buoy our imaginations. They show us places and perspectives we might never otherwise encounter.

Of course, book distribution programs like ours do more than inspire a love of reading; they also build critical early literacy skills that carry young people throughout their lives. Book distribution programs are affordable, scalable, and evidence-based. Simply taking 12 books home in the summer has shown to be as effective as attending summer school. A 20-year study across 27 countries found that a home library of 20 books is enough to propel a child to a higher level of education. The more books you add, the greater the benefit.

For years, the Maryland Book Bank has fielded calls from other states interested to learn how we do what we do. Now, we are proud to be one of the leaders of the National Book Access Association, a group of organizations from across the country that share a mission of getting books into the hands of children who need them most. Together with our partners like First Book, Heart of America, and Little Free Libraries, we will work together to advance the research and practice of book distribution for children everywhere.

The Maryland Book Bank truly did take flight last year, and we have so much to look forward to. In 2024, our Bookmobile will deliver its one-millionth book, and our Home Library Project is poised to reach double the number of students with home libraries to call their own. If you gave your time or resources to the Book Bank in 2023, I thank you, and I encourage everyone to support our efforts in 2024.

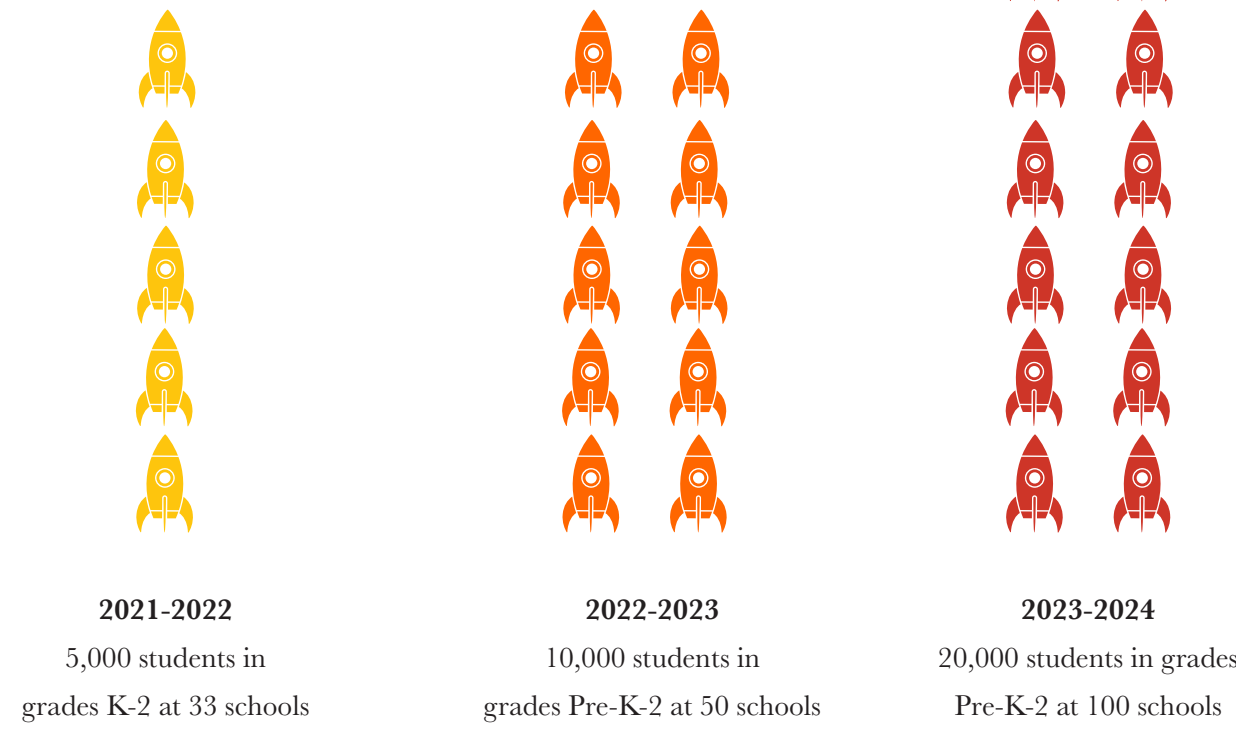

Home Library Project

Multiple studies show that home libraries are associated with increased reading achievement and persistence in school. Since 2017, the Home Library Project (HLP) has given tens of thousands of students in Baltimore City the gift of a home library. Starting in the 2023-2024 school year, each participating school receives an annual visit from the Bookmobile, and Pre-K-2 students take home 10 books matched to their interests and abilities to grow their home libraries along with reading tips and tools for their families.

SNAPSHOT OF HLP GROWTH



In 2022-2023, we successfully expanded the Home Library Project from 33 to 50 schools, reaching nearly 10,000 students with over 100,000 books. This expansion was fueled by the Book Bank's award of six Americorps NCCC members who helped to implement the program last spring.

For the 2023-2024 school year, we listened to educators and made the decision to shift the program from twice annual visits to 50 schools to once annual visits to 100 schools, thereby doubling the number of students we reach. By the end of the four-year program, students will have at least 40 books in their home libraries.





Bookmobile

The Bookmobile is a mobile bookstore where everything is FREE. Our beloved purple community ambassadors invite young people to step inside and confidently select books to take home and cherish forever.

Our two Bookmobiles were very busy in 2023, delivering books to schools and community events, and bringing some of our famous friends along for the ride!

We partnered with Ravens player Roquan Smith's Community Foundation on "Going Back to School in Style," an event that attendees won't soon forget! Smith brought everything families needed for a great back-to-school to the Henderson Hopkins School: 20 barbers and stylists to deliver fresh cuts; the Bookmobile to refresh those home libraries; free backpacks and school supplies; lunch from Chick-fil-A; and tons of activities and games.

Ravens players didn't stop the community giveback there— they also joined us for "Caw to Action" at Baybrook Elementary School. Ravens players visited the Book Bank warehouse to sort and pack books on the Bookmobile and then distributed them at the school. The Book Bank was thrilled to receive a check from Amazon Thursday Night Football at the event.

Just like last year, we "hoppily" brought books to our friends at the Maryland Zoo's Bunny Bonanzoo and gathered and distributed books on the Ravens Walk. The Bookmobiles also brought smiles to the New Teacher Symposium in Montgomery County and Greedy Reads' The Lost Weekend Festival.

Once again, we prevented the summer brain drain by making special visits to all of the Camp Baltimore summer camps at our local rec centers.

Families are reading more because of the Book Bank

- 87% of families report that their child reads more since receiving books from the Book Bank
- 92% report that they read with their children sometimes (37%) or a lot (55%)
- 85% report that their children like to read or love to read





Story Kits

Story Kits are specially boxed packages of five books delivered right to homes or in bulk to schools and tutoring programs for students to take home. Initially a way to deliver books during the pandemic, this program now primarily serves students of The Literacy Lab. In total, we distributed 900 Story Kits totaling 4,500 books in 2023 as a fee-for-service offering of The Book Bank. Schools and partners pay a small fee (\$6 for pick up, \$7 for delivery) for the service.

“The Maryland Book Bank and The Literacy Lab share the core value that literacy is a human right. In the last three years, our partnership with the Maryland Book Bank has allowed us to provide over 2,500 Literacy Lab students in Baltimore City Schools with an individualized Story Kit. The Story Kits create a home-school connection that reinforces the key literacy skills our students are practicing daily with their Literacy Lab tutor or fellow. They also encourage students to find joy in reading by allowing them to access high-quality books at home that align with their individual interests and reading level. We are so grateful to be able to partner with the Maryland Book Bank in our shared mission of improving literacy outcomes in Baltimore City.”

Community Memberships

The warehouse was bustling with activity throughout the year. In addition to our regular visits from members, we hosted special events for educators to “shop” our stacks to fill their classroom shelves. In partnership with the Baltimore Child Care Resource Center, we invited all city daycare owners and Judy Center staff to visit for two special evening events.

In total, we distributed 289,000 books at the warehouse in 2023, serving 5,600 families and educators reaching more than 60,000 children. We also continued our Educator Box program, packaging and distributing 78 boxes of 100 books for educators to pick up and go!

Did you know?

Community Memberships allow members to visit the Book Bank and select their own books for their home, school, or youth program. **Members with our no-cost Community Membership can take up to 25 books per month, and children can always take as many books as they can carry.** The Book Bank’s individual membership costs just \$45 per year and comes with unlimited books, including our Educator Boxes of 100 books for teachers.

Book Sales

Did you know that the Maryland Book Bank runs a thriving e-commerce business? Our social enterprise sells donated books for adults on Amazon to help fund our children’s programs. Now in operation for 11 years, we are so proud of the sustainable support this program provides the Book Bank. We are also proud to employ four staff who learn skills in inventory processing and management. Finally, our book sales operation is eco-friendly, keeping hundreds of thousands of books out of landfills through recycling and reselling.

National Impact

After a decade of local impact, The Maryland Book Bank has become a model program and organization for other book and resource distribution nonprofits across the country. When called upon, we provide best practices in everything from sorting and sourcing books to programming, measuring results, fundraising, and relationship building.

By hosting site visits and taking countless peer-to-peer calls, we have helped programs like New York City’s Book Fairies, Philadelphia’s Book Smiles, and the Cleveland Kids Book Bank get off the ground and become thriving programs.

We were early thought partners of what has become the National Book Access Association, an organization now 130 members strong, including First Book, Reading Partners, and Heart of America. Our Executive Director serves as Treasurer and regularly presents to other programs nationwide on topics involving all aspects of book access and non-profit management.

Finally, our Baltimore Warehouse Collaborative program has become a model for supply-side nonprofits. We are proud to have offered counsel to those replicating our model in Pennsylvania and Ohio. Taken together, our work to expand book distribution nationally amplifies our mission in service of young readers everywhere.

The Baltimore Warehouse Collaborative

The Baltimore Warehouse Collaborative is the home of the Maryland Book Bank, and we love sharing it with our nonprofit friends. The Book Bank is co-located with other supply side nonprofits in one flexible space. Our neighbors include The Movement Team, Leveling the Playing Field, and Break a Difference.

The Movement Team, a mentoring and resource distribution nonprofit, turns unwanted Amazon and Walmart deliveries into stronger communities. The Movement team reaches more than 10,000 community members, youth, and families each year.

Break a Difference recruits volunteers and organizes large-scale service projects and capacity building for nonprofits. Every year, BAD engages over 6,000 volunteers in 300+ projects across 30 cities.

Leveling the Playing Field gathers gently used sports gear from the community and stocks a well-organized warehouse for local teachers and nonprofit coaches to “shop” for their teams at no cost. In 2023, LPF distributed \$1.1M in sports gear to Baltimore programs while also officially launching its chapters in Buffalo, NY, and Columbus, OH.

Our unique collaborative home for supply side nonprofits continues to strengthen our operations and shared connections. In 2023, we held several warehouse-wide volunteer events, welcoming companies like CareFirst, BGE, and Exelon to send large teams of volunteers to help every BCW organization in one day.

Susan and Joanne produced nearly 1,000 Story Kits this year, and the rest of our lead volunteers were instrumental to our Bookmobile program. We were thrilled to host a number of school volunteer groups this year, including a partnership with Anne Arundel County Public Schools' Office of Volunteerism that brought five schools to the warehouse.
